**FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD:** As soon as Jesus was baptised he saw the Spirit of God coming down on him.

**FATHER HUDSON'S 116TH ANNUAL BALL:** The 116th Annual Ball in aid of Father Hudson's Care takes place on Saturday 1st February at St John's Hotel Solihull. This year the proceeds of the Ball will go to St Joseph's Home, where the elderly and infirm, particularly those with dementia are cared for lovingly and professionally.

This year, the Ball is returning to St John's after many years at the National Motorcycle Museum and we are hoping for increased numbers from the Knowle and Dorridge community. Reception is at 7.30pm, a 3-course dinner is served at 8.15pm, dancing to "The Marmites" from 9.30pm with carriages at 1.00am.

**DIOCESAN REGENERATION OFFICE:** When Mgr McHugh came to the Parish in 2001 he was asked by Cardinal (then Archbishop) Nicolls to create and set up the Diocesan Regeneration Office in response to the Government invitation to Faith Bodies to participate in regeneration of deprived areas. Over the years the regeneration work grew and people in the Parish and elsewhere became involved in the 3 Charities Mgr McHugh established for Education and Training; Parish Engagement in Community Regeneration; and use of Premises for the wider Community. Essential in all of this was having space for offices and two of the rooms in the Presbytery were used for this purpose. A short history of the setting up of the Regeneration Office has been written and copies of the booklet are available in the Narthex this weekend; you are welcome to take one. Mgr McHugh wants to say thank you to the Parish and Parishioners who helped him get this work underway. He is now handing it on to his successor Deacon Paul O'Connor, Planning Officer of the Archdiocese.
