**REOPENING OF THE CHURCH FOR SERVICES:** Fr Rob has been told that his shielding will continue until 1st Aug so until then will be unable to celebrate public Masses, Weddings or Baptisms. Masses will continue to be live streamed and parishioners who wish to receive Holy Communion after watching Mass online will be able to do so. Fr Paul will distribute Holy Communion following the weekend Masses.

- To comply with The Government's Track and Trace guidance, people are asked to come with a piece of paper with their name and phone number on, these should be dropped into the basket on entering the Church. They will be kept securely for three weeks before being destroyed.
- Parishioners are asked to wash their hands before setting off for Church.
- Enter the Church through the Narthex, sanitising your hands on the way in, to where Fr Paul will distribute the Holy Eucharist, please receive the Host in outstretched hands and then exit via the Parish Centre.
- You may wish to sit in the Calvary Garden or in your car to say your thanksgiving prayers before returning home.

**THE SVP** is a Catholic charitable society whose aim is ‘faith in action’. The school ‘Mini Vinnies’ club are affiliated to the parish SVP group. Our parish SVP group do daily deliveries of food & supplies to Food Banks, homeless shelters, as well as to drop in centres for asylum seekers & refugees. Due to the current situation, the main Food Bank that they work with are desperately short of provisions and are struggling to meet demand for the most deprived areas of Birmingham. They need urgent donations of food, cleaning products, toiletries and baby products on a large scale. Donations can be dropped off at the school or local addresses for the SVP team to collect every Thursday. Addresses of local drop-off points and newsletters, for an update on how things are going, can be found on the parish website.
