In taking this decision, it has been accepted that the remaining shortfall on the loan, of around £9000.00, will be covered by Parish funds. However, if anyone would like to contribute to reducing the outstanding debt, this would be much appreciated. Finally, the Finance

Committee would like to offer a big *“Thank you”* to all the parishioners who have so generously supported this Project over the last few years and enabled much needed building work to be carried out for the benefit of our primary school children.
